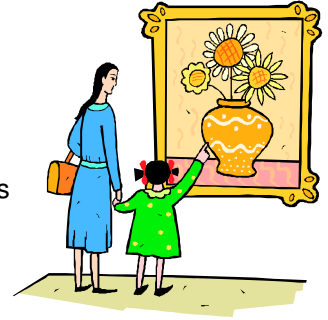


Museum Seminar: Fine Arts Insurance 101
